Shout Outs: School Library Reports

- Focus on Collaborations
- Summaries of Instructional units, highlighting instructional interventions and links to curriculum standards
- Summaries of learning outcomes
- Distribute to principal, library website, board members
- Include direct evidence: tallies, quotes
- Send to multiple recipients: Principal, School Board, include in parent newsletters

- School library website
- Reports
- Newspaper articles
- Research journals, featured research columns
- Teacher journals, discipline-based newsletters
- Exhibitions
- Photo voice & digital story telling



Shout Outs

- Portfolios
